As developed in our 1992 through 1995 ADA Paratransit Plan update submissions to the Federal Transit Administration, the Tuolumne County Public Transportation service, under the name of *Tuolumne County Transit*, is currently in **full compliance** with all six ADA paratransit service requirements and continues to meet the on-going requirements for the public participation of persons with disabilities.

Tuolumne County held its public hearing on this annual ADA Paratransit Plan Update submission to the FTA on February 13, 1996. No one wished to speak at the Public Hearing (see attached minute excerpt). Throughout the past year, our paratransit coordinator met with our advisory committee of persons with disablities to discuss ADA paratransit service relative to the six service criteria.

The Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 26-96 (certified copy attached) approving this 1996 ADA Paratransit Implementation Plan Update.
